The Big Interview

Here prospective Conservative Blaydon MP Glenn Hall talks about why he wants to represent his home town in Parliament

Q. First things first, why do you want to be the MP for Blaydon?

A. It's where I was born and brought up. It's a place I love and it would be a privilege for a local lad like me to fight from within a future Conservative

government to get the best deal for Blaydon in the difficult times ahead. For too long, politics in Blaydon have been dominated by a Lib-Lab political machine that is not representing the needs of the

local community in Westminster. It's time for a real change.

Q. What do you believe in?

A. It's hard to sum up in a few short sentences... but I think families are very important because families form communities and a strong community builds a sense of responsibility in individuals. So, strengthening the family is good for us all in the long term. I also passionately believe in giving everyone a fair chance to aspire to achieve,

whatever their background.

Q. How long have you been involved in politics? A. I've always been interested in local and national issues but I've only recently become involved in politics. I think it's important that politicians have experience of the real world before they go into public life. A record of hard work and achievement helps the voters to have confidence in the ability and character of the person they are voting for. I joined the Conservatives in 2007 and became a local councillor in Kent, which is where I now live to be close to my current job. I

think it's important to put something back into the community. It's hard to juggle family life, my job and community work but it's very satisfying.

Q. What do you think are the most important issues facing the country?

A. There can be no denying that the country is in a mess and something has to change to get it back on its feet. Do you know that the government is borrowing £6000 every second? I find that shocking. In the time it takes you to read this sentence the UK has borrowed more than most people earn in a whole year.

Just paying the debt back could cripple us. We need to build an economy based on sound financial principles and a society based on the values of aspiration, responsibility and fairness. Gordon Brown is a weak Prime Minister leading a divided government that continues to make mistakes. That's not what Blaydon needs.

Q. What's your best memory of growing up in the Blaydon constituency?

A. Well, I really remember the trip to Wembley with my Dad in 1981 to see Whickham play in the FA Vase Final. Hundreds of people from Whickham and the surrounding area travelled down to London together on the same train. It created a great community spirit and the whole thing was quite an experience for a twelve year old. And we won!


IT'S A TWO HORSE RACE!
