### 75% CUT IN IMMIGRATION

David Cameron recently announced that immigration would be cut by as much as 75% under a Conservative government to prevent Britain's population hitting 70million.

On immigration, Mr. Cameron said that he was focused on the pressure on our public services, including health, education, housing and prisons created by the new immigrant arrivals.

He also said a Conservative Government would set an annual migration cap, determined each year depending on the needs of the economy. We don't support Britain's population reaching 70 million! Britain simply wouldn't cope.

In the past ten years net migration - the difference between the numbers leaving and arriving, had been around 200,000 a year. David Cameron wants to return the low figures seen under previous Conservative governments

A Conservative Government has pledged to:

- Set limits on economic migration from outside the EU substantially lower than the current rate;
- Set up a border police force with powers to track down and remove illegal immigrants;
- And impose transitional controls on the right of nationals of the new EU member states to work in the UK.
