
## A winning choice for Hampstead & Kilburn

Chris was born and brought up a Londoner, and attended a state school here. Despite his teacher telling him at 13 that he would always be bottom of the class in Science, against the odds, Chris made it to Oxford, and graduated with a Physics degree.

Locally, Chris was elected to the Gospel Oak ward of Camden Council in May, beating the sitting Labour Leader with a 10% Conservative swing - the biggest in the Borough and easily enough to win Hampstead & Kilburn at the next election. It was thought impossible for Conservatives to win Gospel Oak, but with lots of hard work, we did - reaching out to 100s of new Conservative voters in Council estates that had rarely seen a Conservative before.

Nationally, Chris has been Chairman of the Bow Group and helped lead the Conservative Party's national campaign on the NHS at the 2005 General Election, personally generating many of the headlines about MRSA. He has also advised the Shadow Cabinet on key policy issues over the last 5 years.

Chris is a successful local businessman, who has set up three companies in North London, which now employ hundreds of people. In 2003, he was voted by the Times and Ernst & Young as London's "Entrepreneur of the Future". He is also passionate about helping others achieve success, so sits on the board of a charity promoting start-ups in deprived communities and has been an inner city school governor. Chris has lived in Hampstead with Natasha for the last six years. They are both keen runners, along with their 8 year old Collie-cross-Alsatian, Bobby.

## Political Priorities

### Health

The Royal Free lost 180 staff in the last 6 months - including 27 doctors. 20% of the NHS's staff are central bureaucrats and there are now more "senior managers" in the NHS than GPs. *Hospitals must be given freedom from Government interference to run their own affairs, saving the huge cost of central bureaucracy - which can then be re-invested in front-line services.*

### Crime

Criminals should be running scared - not the public. In Camden, the police reported 42,035 crimes last year - 5,000 more than the previous year. *The Met spends £122m per year on admin - more than twice what they spend investigating burglaries. We need the Police to catch up with criminals, not their paperwork!*

### Education

State schools are falling far behind private ones. It is unfair that the only way to get a good education is to buy it. I want all children to have the chance to make it from a state school to Oxford, like I did. *Schools should enjoy complete freedom from Government interference, and urgent action is needed on basic literacy and numeracy.*

### Environment

*We need to urgently work to increase recycling, reduce pollution, and protect our beautiful environment from further over-development.*
